

VISA APPLICATION PROCEDURE

(RESIDENTS IN JAPAN ONLY)

Types of Visa

✧Application form and personal history form are downloadable from our official website.

A visa application should be submitted directly to the Consular Section after with the required document which are mentioned in the following section:

A. TRANSIT VISA

The maximum length of stay is 14 days from the date of arrival in Indonesia.

Documents required:

1. A completed and signed visa application form
2. Passport (must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry into Indonesia)
3. 1 recent (within the past 6 months) photograph in color (L.4cm X W.3 cm)
4. For Seaman, 1 copy of Seaman's Book and original Book
5. Letter of recommendation from the employer in Japan
6. Copy of passport (ID page, in A4 size)
7. Personal History
8. Airline tickets/Confirmation slip
9. Visa Fee ¥ 2,400
10. Additional documents may be requested under certain circumstances

B. SINGLE VISIT VISAS

✧ TOURIST VISA

The maximum length of stay is 30 days from the date of arrival in Indonesia

Document required:

1. A completed and signed visa application form
2. Passport (must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry into Indonesia)
3. 1 recent (within the past 6 months) photograph in color (L.4cm X W.3 cm)

4. Certificate of employment / Student Registration Certificate / Letter of Reference
5. Round Trip Airline tickets/Confirmation slip
6. Copies of Alien Registration Card (Front and back side in A4 size)
7. Re-entry permit (must be valid until the applicant returns to Japan)
8. Signed Statement
9. Copy of passport (ID page, in A4 size)
10. Personal History
11. Visa Fee ¥ 5,400
12. Additional documents may be requested under certain circumstances

✧ **SINGLE BUSINESS VISA**

(Except for the Press / Public Communications / Shooting Film)

The maximum length of stay is 30 or 60 days from the date of arrival in Indonesia

Document required:

1. A completed and signed visa application form
2. Passport (must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry into Indonesia)
3. 1 recent (within the past 6 months) photograph in color (L.4cm X W.3 cm)
4. Letter of Invitation from business counterpart / sponsor in Indonesia
5. Letter of Recommendation from the employer in Japan
6. Copy of passport (ID page, in A4 size)
7. Personal History
8. Round Trip Airline tickets/Confirmation slip
9. For the Press / Public Communications / Shooting Film, Letter of Approval from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Jakarta, and legalized Equipment List
10. Visa Fee ¥ 5,400
11. Additional documents may be requested under certain circumstances

✧ **SOCIAL VISIT VISA**

The maximum length of stay is 30 or 60 days from the date of arrival in Indonesia

Document required:

1. A completed and signed visa application form
2. Passport (must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry into Indonesia)
3. 1 recent (within the past 6 months) photograph in color (L.4cm X W.3 cm)
4. Letter of Invitation from the organization / inviter in Indonesia
5. Letter of Recommendation from the organization / guarantor in Japan
6. Copy of passport (ID page, in A4 size)
7. Personal History
8. Round Trip Airline tickets/Confirmation slip
9. Visa Fee ¥ 5,400
10. Additional documents may be requested under certain circumstances

❖ **FAMILY VISIT VISA**

The maximum length of stay is 30 or 60 days from the date of arrival in Indonesia

Document required:

1. A completed and signed visa application form
2. Passport (must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry into Indonesia)
3. 1 recent (within the past 6 months) photograph in color (L.4cm X W.3 cm)
4. Letter of Invitation from the relatives in Indonesia
5. Letter of Recommendation from the relatives in Japan
6. Original Family Registration and translation in English or Indonesian (Signature of translator is needed) **OR** Original Marriage Certificate / Birth certificate and copy, **OR** in the case of visit to friend, copy of ID Card of inviter is needed.
7. Copy of Passport (ID page, in A4 size)
8. Personal History
9. Round Trip Airline tickets/Confirmation slip
10. Visa Fee ¥ 5,400
11. Additional documents may be requested under certain circumstances

C. LIMITED STAY VISA

The maximum length of stay depends on the Letter of Approval from the Director General of Immigration in Jakarta.

Document required:

1. A completed and signed visa application form
2. Passport (must be valid for at least 6 – 24 months depends on Letter of Approval)
3. 1 recent (within the past 6 months) photograph in color (L.4cm X W.3 cm)
4. Letter of Approval from the Director General of Immigration in Jakarta.
5. Letter of Recommendation from the relatives in Japan
6. Copy of Passport (ID page, in A4 size)
7. Personal History
8. Round Trip Airline tickets/Confirmation slip (If the length of stay is more than 12 months, one way ticket is acceptable)
9. Visa Fee ¥ 5,400 (up to 6 months)
12. Additional documents may be requested under certain circumstances

D. MULTIPLE VISIT VISA

The maximum length of stay is 60 days from the date of arrival in Indonesia. Applicant must meet some requirements before applying for this visa.

Documents required :

1. A completed and signed visa application form
2. Passport (must be valid for at least 18 months from the entry into Indonesia)
3. 1 recent (within the past 6 months) photograph in color (L.4cm X W.3 cm)

4. Letter of Invitation from business / sponsor in Indonesia
5. Letter of Recommendation from the relatives in Japan
6. Copy of Passport (ID page, in A4 size)
7. Personal History
8. Round Trip Airline tickets/Confirmation slip
9. Visa Fee ¥ 12,000,-
10. Additional documents may be requested under certain circumstances

Payment Procedure of Visa Application Fee

Payment slip for visa fee is provided after submitting documents. Please complete the payment indicated on the payment slip at nearby post office before the date of receipt. When you receive your passport with new visa, please submit a receipt issued by post office. We issue you a receipt for visa application fee.

Visa on Arrival

Entry Requirements for Visa on Arrival:

1. Passport must be valid for a at least 6 months as of the date of entry into Indonesia
2. Round Trip Airline tickets/Confirmation slip
3. Visa Fee US\$ 25 (up to 30 days)
